Project Overview

The Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment (OIPI), the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), and the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) are developing a plan to study the entire length of the Interstate 81 (I-81) corridor in the Commonwealth of Virginia. As directed in Senate Bill 971 (now 2018 Acts of Assembly Chapter 743), the study team will identify targeted improvements along I-81 and potential revenue sources that could be dedicated to improvements.

The I-81 Corridor Improvement Plan will:

- Identify segments of I-81 for improvement
- Identify targeted sets of improvements for each segment that can be financed by evaluated revenue options

- Include corridor-wide incident management strategies
- Evaluate concepts to minimize the impact on local truck traffic, diversion of truck traffic, and additional locations for truck parking
- Assess economic impacts on the corridor from tolling only heavy commercial trucks

The study team is evaluating the following:

- Safety crash rate and crash frequency
- Congestion person-hours of delay
- Resiliency incident-related delay and multi-hour lane closures

There are three phases of the study:

- 1. Problem identification
- 2. Preliminary alternatives
- 3. Heavy commerical truck tolling feasibility and economic impacts
